

WEDDING FLOWER

Checklist

PERSONAL FLOWERS

- Choose personal flowers for the couple and wedding party
- Select the bride's bouquet to suit personality and wedding palette
- Choose bouquet flowers and seasonal foliage
- Ask your florist about seasonal flowers for your date and budget
- Add a tossing bouquet for the bouquet toss tradition
- Tell your florist if you want a tossing bouquet
- Choose a bouquet size that feels comfortable to carry
- Add a sentimental detail to the bouquet if desired
- Choose bridesmaids' bouquets to match dresses and theme
- Vary bridesmaids' bouquet colours or flowers if preferred
- Choose flower girl flowers, petals, or a floral wand
- Ensure flower girl arrangements are lightweight and easy to carry
- Choose buttonholes for groom, groomsmen and key male figures
- Choose corsages for mothers, grandmothers and honoured women

WEDDING CEREMONY FLOWERS

- Add flowers to your ceremony entrance
- Use urns or floral pillars to frame doors or pathways
- Choose lanterns or cascading arrangements for stairs or railings
- Add a flower arch to frame your vows
- Decide on full coverage, asymmetry, or flowers with draped fabric
- Add aisle flowers to pews, chairs, or the ground
- Use tied bouquets, hanging jars, or garlands along the aisle
- Use shepherd hooks, petals and greenery for outdoor aisles
- Choose altar arrangements to suit the ceremony space
- Confirm ceremony décor rules with the officiant or coordinator
- Move altar arrangements to the reception after the ceremony
- Choose a chuppah for a Jewish wedding ceremony
- Decorate the chuppah with flowers, greenery and fabric
- Personalise the chuppah with heirloom fabric or symbolic flowers
- Provide petals for guests to toss during your exit
- Hand out petals in cones, packets, or baskets
- Confirm whether your venue allows fresh, dried or biodegradable petals

WEDDING RECEPTION FLOWERS

Add flowers at the reception to carry your floral vision through

Decorate the welcome table with a vase or small arrangement

Add flowers to the seating chart or escort card display

Frame the seating display with florals or a garland

Choose table centrepieces to suit your tablescape and lighting

Consider guest visibility when choosing centrepiece height

Add fresh flowers to your wedding cake

Confirm cake flowers are food-safe and securely arranged

Add a floral installation or greenery behind the top table

Decorate chairs with florals, garlands, or swags

Add flowers to the guest book table

Add a floral photo backdrop for guest photos

Decorate food stations with small clusters of flowers or greenery

Add floral accents to the bar with bud vases

Add greenery or garlands around the bar if desired

Add small arrangements to cocktail tables

Use bud vases or single stems for cocktail tables
